It is absolutely vital that you call your House and Senate Legislators and tell

them that you want a bill to protect the physical privacy of your children before tomorrow at noon! WE NEED ABSOLUTELY EVERYONE TO MAKE AT LEAST ONE CALL!

Here is why:

The Minneapolis School District quietly passed a policy in 2014 to allow students to “self-select” into the group of their gender identity and then went on to allow them to separate themselves by that chosen gender which means that students of both sexes will share locker rooms, dressing rooms, bathrooms and other private facilities. This also allows students to “self-select” which athletic teams they play on and even take courses meant specifically for one sex only.

On Tuesday, March 17, St. Paul Schools will vote to adopt almost an identical “gender inclusive” policy by redefining the meaning of “gender” to nothing more than a “social construct [constructing your own reality] ...attached to femininity or masculinity.” In other words, DNA and science is wrong and there is no longer such a thing as two sexes: male and female. There is only the condition of being masculine or feminine according to how you feel.

Friends, this is outrageous! It is the theatre of the absurd. And if it were not such a dangerous threat to our children, we would not even believe it. But trust me. This is true and parents **don't even know it is happening!** The dangerous intrusion into the physical privacy of our children's lives will inevitably do harm in irreparable ways. The gender confusion alone, promoted by these policies, threatens the very humanity of our children. The suicide rate of transgender people is 40%.

This is unspeakable! We cannot let this happen. We must all call for a bill in this legislative session that will secure the right of every child to his or her physical privacy and safety. If we cannot secure this for our children during the school day, then we cannot send them into the classroom. We must have protective legislation.

A recent Minnesota poll conducted by one of the nation's leading public opinion research firms, found that 90% of voters agree that students have the right to privacy in bathrooms, locker rooms and showers, with facilities that separate biological males and females.

The MN Legislature has been in session for almost two months and we still do not have a bill. There **is a bill** drafted, waiting in the wings, but YOU are the one who can get it finally introduced. They need your support and encouragement, and we are confident that they will do the right thing. This is no time to be bashful!

Please call right now and tell your legislators that you want a law to secure physical privacy for your children that separates biological boys and girls? Go to (website) to get the numbers for your legislators.

It is urgent that we act right now, this week! We need a bill before any more schools adopt this unthinkable policy. Your school or mine might be considering it right now. Will you please call?

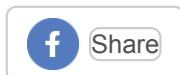
